Qualification requirements for positions entailing doctoral competence or equivalent at AHO Appointments and promotion

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: SCIENTIFIC

Qualification requirements

Norwegian or foreign doctoral degree approved as being equivalent to a Norwegian doctoral degree in the subject area

Basis for assessment

Emphasis is placed on recent academic production, quality, originality and innovation

A reasonable number of publications (specified in the guide) must demonstrate the potential to shape and develop the field of study

Relevant expertise in educational theory and practice based on education or teaching and supervision

Skills and experience regarding academic management, collaboration and administration

Relevant individual, professional development and experience regarding the development of and participation in research projects

Experience in establishing interdisciplinary networks, both nationally and internationally

PROFESSOR: SCIENTIFIC

Qualification requirements

Significant scientific production exceeding associate professor qualification requirements, corresponding scope of two doctoral theses in different and relevant fields of study

Basis for assessment

Extensive production of international peer-reviewed works and publications

Emphasis is placed on academic production over the past 10 years. Documented sustained research activity

Relevant expertise in educational theory and practice based on education or teaching and supervision

Significant supervisory experience (MA and PhD students)

Significant experience in academic management, collaboration and administration. Significant experience in the development of and participation in research projects. Significant experience in establishing interdisciplinary international networks.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR: RELATED TO ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN (ARTISTIC)

Qualification requirements

A high level of academic specialisation within our fields of study

Basis for assessment

At least three projects that have been implemented or made a significant academic impact at a high level, where the applicant can document a central role in key phases of the work (specified for the school's subject areas in the guide)

The pieces of works must demonstrate the potential to shape and develop the field of study

Production with emphasis placed on recent works juried in competitions or published/reviewed in internationally recognised academic journals and exhibitions, put into production, or equivalent

Emphasis is placed on quality, originality and innovation

Relevant expertise in educational theory and practice based on education or teaching and supervision

Skills and experience of academic management, collaboration and administration. Experience in establishing interdisciplinary networks, both nationally and internationally

PROFESSOR: RELATED TO ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN (ARTISTIC)

Qualification requirements

A high international level of profiled specialisation in architectural or design activities

Basis for assessment

At least five projects that have been implemented or made a significant academic impact at a high international level, where the applicant can document a central role in key phases of the work (specified for the school's subject areas in the guide)

Emphasis is placed on works from the last ten years, especially projects juried/published in internationally recognised competitions, academic journals and exhibitions, put into production, or equivalent. These works must demonstrate that the applicant has shaped and developed the field of study

Emphasis is placed on quality, originality and innovation

Relevant expertise in educational theory and practice based on education or teaching and supervision (BA/MA students)

Ability to continuously carry out independent professional development work of relevance to the position, at a high academic level

Significant experience in academic management, collaboration and administration

Significant experience in the development of and participation in architectural or design research projects, and significant experience in establishing international interdisciplinary networks

For certain positions, a combination of scientific and architectural and design (artistic) qualifications will be relevant, where scientific qualifications may form part of the requirements described above.
