Ny Langtidsplan for forskning og høyere utdanning

In FU 17 November FU will discuss and decide upon which five calls that should be supported as AHOs PhD positions in 2023. To make sure the process and discussion will be as transparent as possible, Vice-rector Lise Amy Hansen would like to discuss this in FU.

In addition, FU decided last year to not appoint external expert committees to assess the applications and do this internally at AHO instead. There is a need to discuss this and map out how this is handled in practical manners.

In addition to the discussion around the PhD calls, FU also was presented with the decision from the PhD programme committee to end the PhD by Practice pilot. This was based on the external evaluation and internal discussion in the programme board, where the conclusion is that AHO has one academic PhD and that the PhD by Practice students can fulfill the pilots ambitions with the three PhD thesis formats AHO allows.
